

The Rev'd Dr Ben Vertannes—12 May (wk 4)

Ben has been a curate in Streatham, South London for the last two years. His background is in the study of medieval history, secondary school teaching and a spot of football refereeing. A particular focus of his parish work is ministry with children and young people.

The Rev'd Canon Prof. Mark Chapman—19th May (wk 5)

Mark David Chapman is Vice-Principal and Academic Dean of Ripon College Cuddesdon, Professor of the History of Modern Theology at the University of Oxford and Canon Theologian of Truro. He has written on many different aspects of Anglicanism, Church history and theology.





The Rev'd Dr Carys Walsh—The University Sermon 6th May (wk 6)

Carys Walsh has for many years worked in discernment and formation in the Church of England. She has been a psychotherapist, taught in a theological college and has long been inspired by how poetry can open up to us the depths of faith, and speaks and writes on this regularly.
