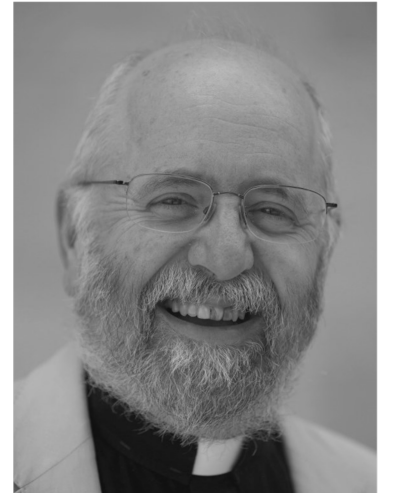


The Rev'd Dr Ben Vertannes—12 May (wk 4)

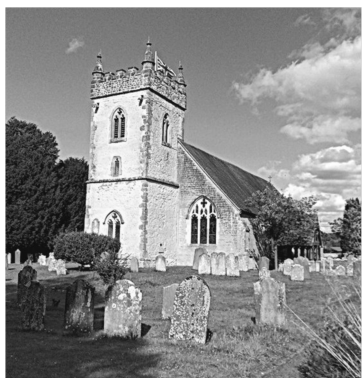
The Rev'd Canon Prof. Mark Chapman—19th May (wk 5)
